- February was a busy month, but I'm happy to report several achievements:
- We successfully co-hosted the Ahkameyimok Oskaya Youth Gathering alongside Heart Lake and Whitefish Lake through Mamowe (MOTCFS). The event saw strong participation from youth within our three communities, as well as from surrounding areas.
- I want to extend my thanks to my fellow leaders for their support in holding Lac La Biche County accountable for the upkeep and maintenance of Township Road 660A. I'm pleased to share that the County has included repairs in their 2025 budget, with work scheduled to be completed this summer. Additionally, they have sent a letter of support to three Ministers regarding the much-needed improvements to Gladue Trail, the roadway leading to Spruce Point Campground. With their backing, we remain hopeful that these improvements will enhance safety for our members.
- Finding a solution for decommissioning our Nation's landfill remains a high priority, and I continue to work toward a viable resolution.
- I have also been in communication with NAIT's Community Engagement Specialist, Chase Gallagher, regarding an Introduction to Building Trades Program. This initiative could be applied to a community project or smaller-scale projects for individual students. I will be reviewing this opportunity with the appropriate departments and leadership to explore ways to bring this program to life for our members.

I look forward to seeing these important initiatives move forward and will continue working to support our communities.
