With the Committee now at full capacity, we will be moving forward with our next Community Engagement Session scheduled for May 23, 2026.

Please be advised that while this date was previously identified for amendment voting, it will no longer serve as a voting date.

Instead, the May 23, 2026 session will be held for the purpose of community engagement, including:

- Review and discussion of proposed amendments
- Opportunity for members to ask questions and provide input
- Clarification of amendments that will be brought forward for voting

This engagement session is an essential part of the amendment process. Members are strongly encouraged to attend and participate to ensure that future voting is informed and reflective of the Nation's voice.

Important Clarification:

This is not a leadership election vote.

The upcoming amendment vote will determine the Election Law framework that will guide future elections in accordance with Beaver Lake Cree Nation governance.

The Election Law Committee remains committed to a transparent, fair, and community-driven process.

We encourage all members to attend and take part in shaping the laws that guide our Nation.
